The economics and rural sociology team is part of a broader effort with environmental scientists, crop & soil scientists, and environmental engineers that are building integrated models of Alabama farms to ensure increased irrigation is also sustainable. This is a 24-month limited-term appointment and is funded from external sources. assist with building models of the irrigation economics on model farms around Alabama. This individual will also work with four other Auburn University agricultural economics and rural sociology faculty in the development and refining of farm models. Interdisciplinary work is also expected with agricultural scientists and engineers on the broader Auburn University team to integrate scientific results and models into the representative economic farm models.
