**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:** A B.S. or B.A. degree in applied agricultural sciences (Entomology, Plant Pathology, Agronomy, or related discipline) with a strong background in English, or a degree related to Education and Biology with a background in Entomology, Plant Pathology and/or weed science. The successful candidate must possess strong writing and editing skills. An M.S. degree is desired.
