Job Description

The University of Nevada, Reno, Extension is recruiting a full-time Lecturer II / Teaching Assistant Professor (12-month, Non-Tenure Track) OR Assistant Professor (12-month, Tenure Track), Extension Educator for Churchill County Nevada location in Fallon, NV.

The primary role of the Extension Educator is to establish community-based education programming in agriculture, animal production, children, youth and families, horticulture, community development, natural resources, and health and nutrition. The duties of the position include assessing community needs, developing and implementing relevant educational programming, and documenting program outcomes and impacts. Since Churchill County is a hub of the local food movement and agriculture, the candidate will provide expertise in food production. This position provides oversight of the 4-H staff and program and serves as the local university liaison with the county government. Additional roles and responsibilities include: 1) facilitating collaboration within the community; 2) providing subject matter expertise to colleagues in Cooperative Extension and/or the University of Nevada, Reno; 3) developing resources (grants, gifts, budget enhancements) as needed; 4) providing professional development to peers, collaborators, and self; 5) creating appropriate research, scholarly and/or creative works (peer-reviewed extension and journal publications, presentations at professional meetings, use of electronic media, etc.); 5) providing oversight and management of the Churchill County Extension Office and related resources; and 6) assuming professionalism with all internal and external audiences, ensuring proactive communication. This position requires a commitment to work effectively with diverse cultural and community interests and develop and maintain solid working relationships.
