Job Description

The Environmental Studies Program at Tufts University (Medford, MA) invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track, lecturer position in Environmental Data Science and Communication beginning September 1, 2023. This position is a 9-month academic appointment with a two-year initial contract and possibility of renewal thereafter. The lecturer will teach the equivalent of three courses per semester, including both introductory and upper-level courses such as: *Introduction to Environmental Studies* or equivalent; *Introduction to Environmental Fieldwork*; and Environmental Data classes such as *Environmental Data Literacy and Story Telling* and/or *Environmental Data, Analysis & Visualization*. Other classes might include a *Senior Capstone* course and advanced seminars in the applicant's area
