In the remaining 20% of your time, you will provide direction and support to the environmental horticulture and the Nature Coast Master Gardener program with the help of a dedicated program assistant. You will demonstrate excellent customer service and you will respond to client needs in a timely and professional manner. Your office will be located at the Levy County Extension Office in Bronson, FL at 625 N. Hathaway Ave, Bronson, FL. This position may include occasional overnight travel, the use of personal transportation, and/or personal cell phone.

Minimum expected progress is earning 50% of credits towards obtaining your master's degree within the first 6 years of employment. To be hired at the Agent II-IV ranks, candidates must hold an MS degree and rank will be determined according to UF rank requirements.

- Experience with digital communication.

- A commitment to serving all Floridians according to UF/IFAS Extension guidelines.
