This position will focus on our largest and newest project, the Natural Infrastructure Innovation Project, which is sponsored by Engineering with Nature. The NIIP launched October 1, 2023, and is proposed to run for five years. The aim of the NIIP is to conduct design research into *what* forms of natural infrastructure are possible in the nation's bays and estuaries, *which* forms are most desirable, and *how* to increase innovation in natural infrastructure design. To do this, the NIIP engages deeply with EWN, local USACE districts, and a broad range of other stakeholders, while utilizing landscape architectural techniques including fieldwork, mapping, iterative design, and physical and numerical hydrodynamic modeling.
