students and faculty in the wildlife program. The successful candidate for this position is expected to teach an undergraduate course in applied data analysis (WILD 5750) that is foundational to several majors in the College, and also contribute to undergraduate and graduate education within the wildlife program by teaching additional courses. The specifics of these additional courses would be based on the candidate's specialty area and the needs of the wildlife program, and would be developed in coordination with the Dean's office. The candidate will also be expected to establish an extramurally funded research program in their specialty area.
