What You'll Do

This Impact Analyst position offers an exciting and challenging opportunity to help improve food, nutrition, and agriculture policy and programming through Tufts University support for the global Agriculture, Nutrition, & Health (ANH) Academy.

<u>The ANH Academy</u> is jointly funded by the Gates Foundation and the United Kingdom's Foreign Commonwealth & Development Office, through the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM). This project convenes a global community of interdisciplinary researchers, practitioners, and policymakers working on agriculture and food systems for improved nutrition and health, with over 10,000 members in 160 countries.

The Impact Analyst will collaborate with other members of the ANH Academy staff at Tufts University and LSHTM to manage expansion of current programs to deliver impact; analyse and visualize data to support monitoring, evaluation, and learning (MEL) activities; and support research projects to meet ANH Academy program objectives. This position will be supervised by the ANH Academy Project Manager based at Tufts University.

Duties will include but are not limited to: updating and developing new content for the ANH Academy Support Center for Agriculture – Nutrition Research (SCANR), ANH Research Communities and other efforts to attract new members and achieve program goals; designing and conducting data analysis and visualization activities that demonstrate program impact; coordinating research activities and planning; liaising between relevant internal and external stakeholder groups; providing technical support and data analysis for ongoing research aims; and disseminating MEL or research findings in reports or events.

Essential Functions in this role will be: Development and delivery of program content

- Attract new ANH Academy members and meet project goals through updated and expanded content for the Support Centre for Agriculture-Nutrition Research (SCANR) and related activities such as Research Communities and Teaching Materials
- Plan and track timelines and action items for ANH Academy staff and collaborators on research activities, events, conferences, and meetings
- Maintain communication with ANH Academy staff and collaborators to ensure timely, responsive delivery of program content
- Create and maintain meeting agendas, minutes and associated files when needed 40% Data analysis and visualization
- Conduct data analysis projects to measure and visualize program outputs, outcomes, and impacts
- Work collaboratively with the team MEL lead to share progress and lessons learned from ANH Academy activities using the MEL framework, collecting data as necessary.
- Create MEL reports and multi-media presentations for activities or groups of activities. 30%

Research support

- Obtain and analyze data, create charts and tables, update software tools and documentation using R, Stata, Excel and other environments, and
- Conduct literature reviews and write manuscripts for publication in academic journals as well as research summaries for websites and social media, in partnership with ANH Academy staff and collaborators
