- Prepare and deliver presentations, reports, and training materials for local stakeholders, and maintain records of farmer consultations, field diagnostics, and intervention outcomes.
- Maintain comprehensive, up-to-date records for each participating farm and coordinate logistics and tracking for shared-use equipment.
- Work closely with the Alcorn Extension and contractor team to implement shared-use infrastructure, co-op agreements, and terms of use for equipment
- Identify barriers and provide feedback to the Associate Director for Extension Program
- Collect informal and formal feedback from farmers on program performance
